The Board of Trustees met at the Township Building at 7:00 p.m. on January 12th, 2022.

Roll call was taken. Trustees Frevert, Berry, Graham and Kretzer responded present. Supervisor Heberling, Clerk Gronewald and Highway Commissioner West also responded present.

Motion to approve December minutes was made by Trustee Graham and Seconded by Trustee Kretzer. All said aye and motion was passed.

Motion to approve the Supervisors bills was made by Trustee Frevert and seconded by Trustee Berry. All said aye and motion was passed.

Supervisor Heberling discussed that the remodeling of the Township building is ongoing as planned and the Town and Road District budgets are done and will be voted on at the February 9th, 2022 meeting. Also discussed was the change in Missy Ruffs salary to be taken from the General Assistants fund instead of the Road Fund. Supervisor Heberling suggested that the Attorney budget be increased from \$5,000.00 to \$25,000.00. Discussion was tabled for future review. Also discussed; The Economic Statement of Interest is to be completed and that everyone needs to complete the Open Acts on line course.

Highway Commissioner West stated that the snow plows are ready for any inclement weather.

Supervisor Heberling also discussed the remodel progress. Light fixtures are to be replaced and Charlie Samson is painting the strips in the ceiling tiles. Also discussed were the Town and Road District budgets. The legal fees are to be increased to \$50,000.00 in the Town budget. Both budgets were signed by Trustees and all said aye.

An email was received from Langleyville resident, Kent Collebrusco, detailing issues in town and asking for consideration of attention to said problems.

Motion to adjourn was made by Trustee Frevert and seconded by Trustee Graham. All said aye and motion was passed and adjournment was at 7:54 p.m.

Commissioner West questioned the high bill for the gas and gas tank and that payment was put on hold until more information could be obtained.
